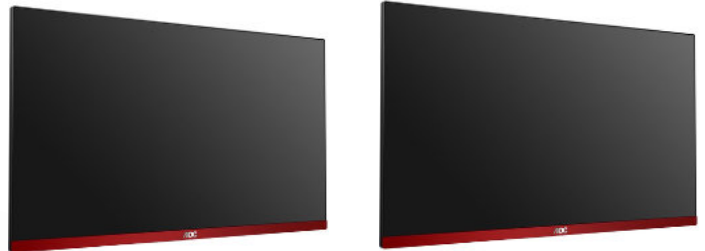

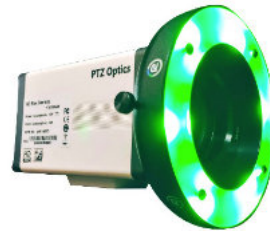

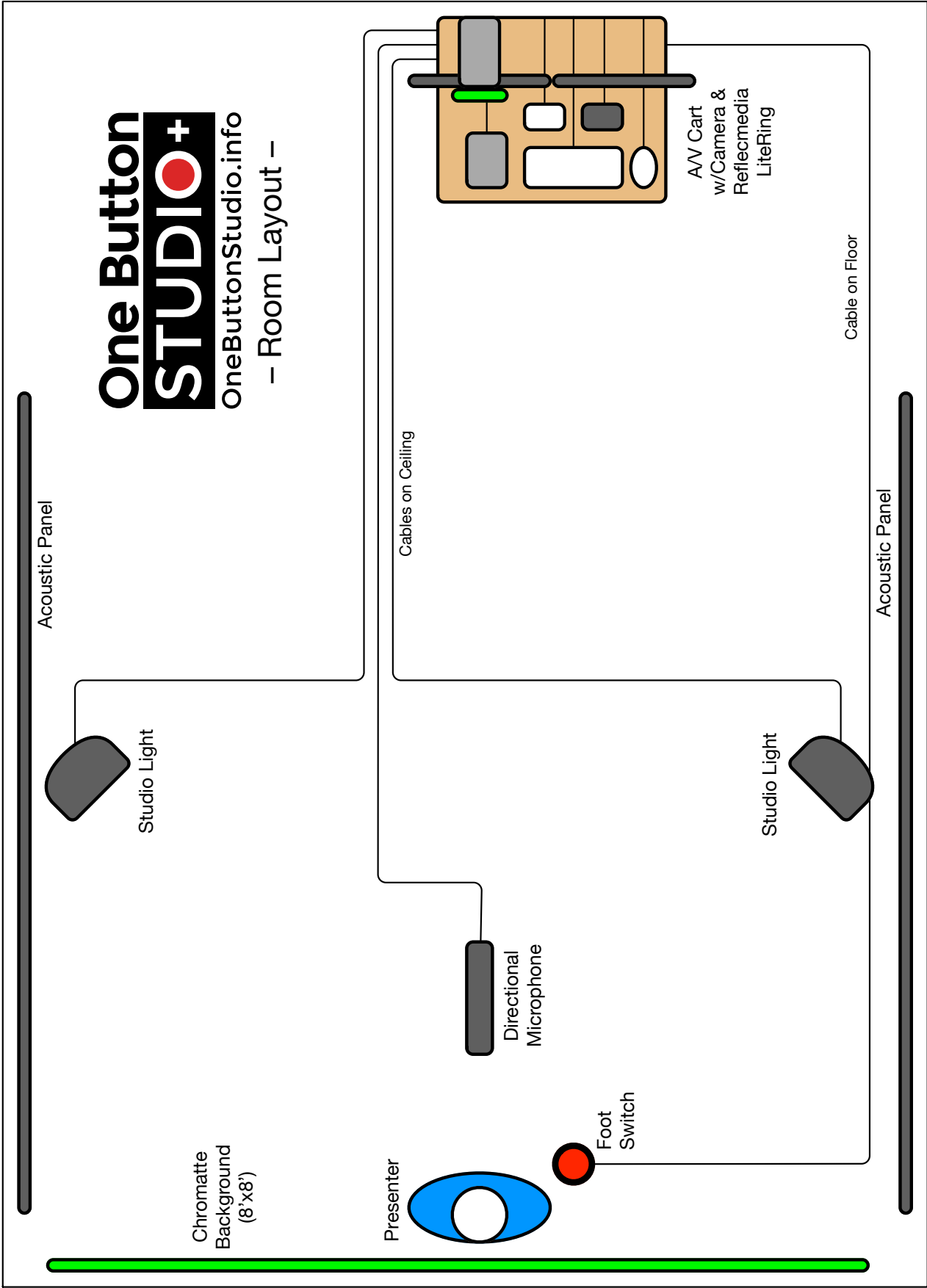

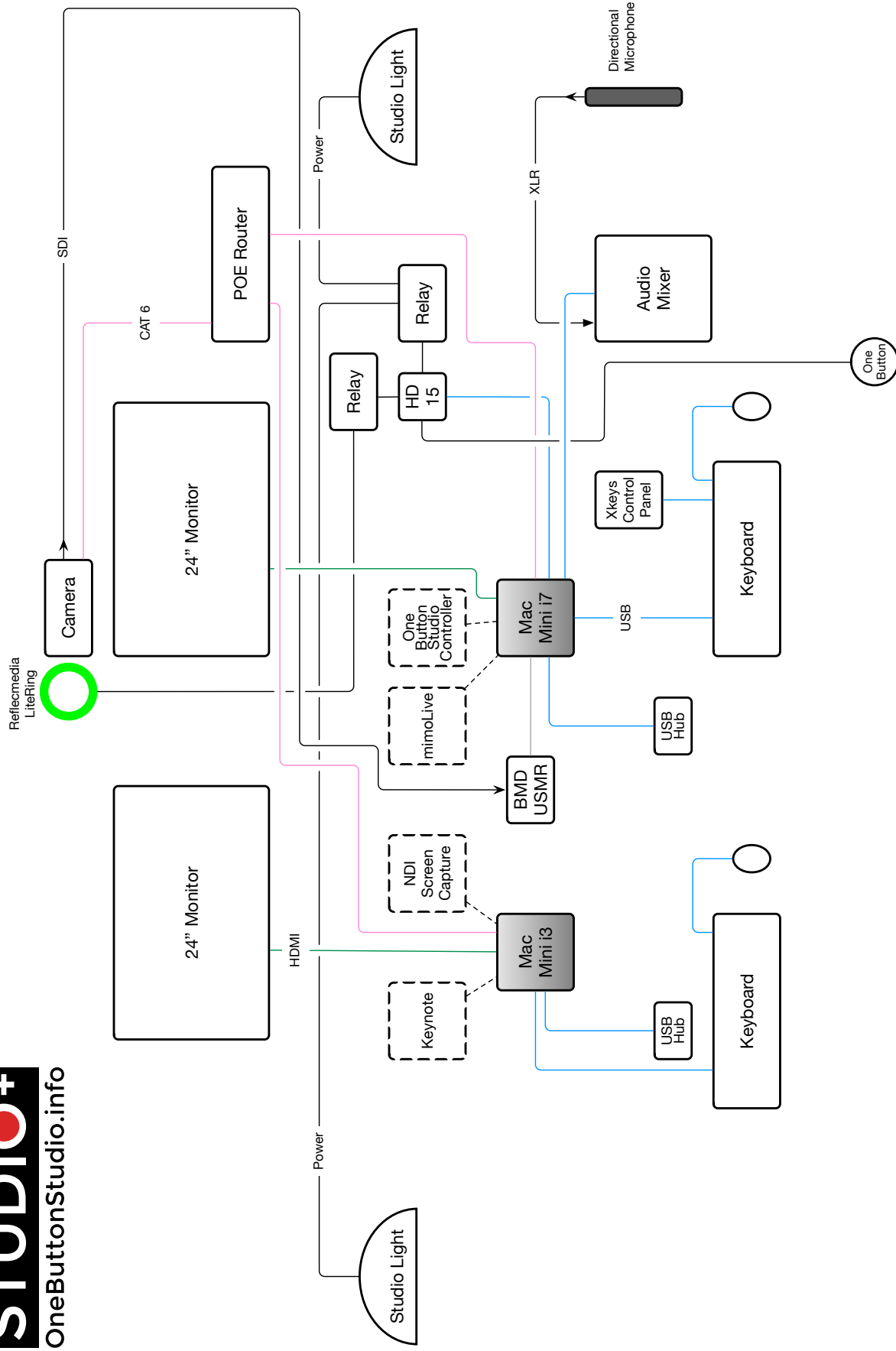

Step 1: Monitor Mount & Monitors



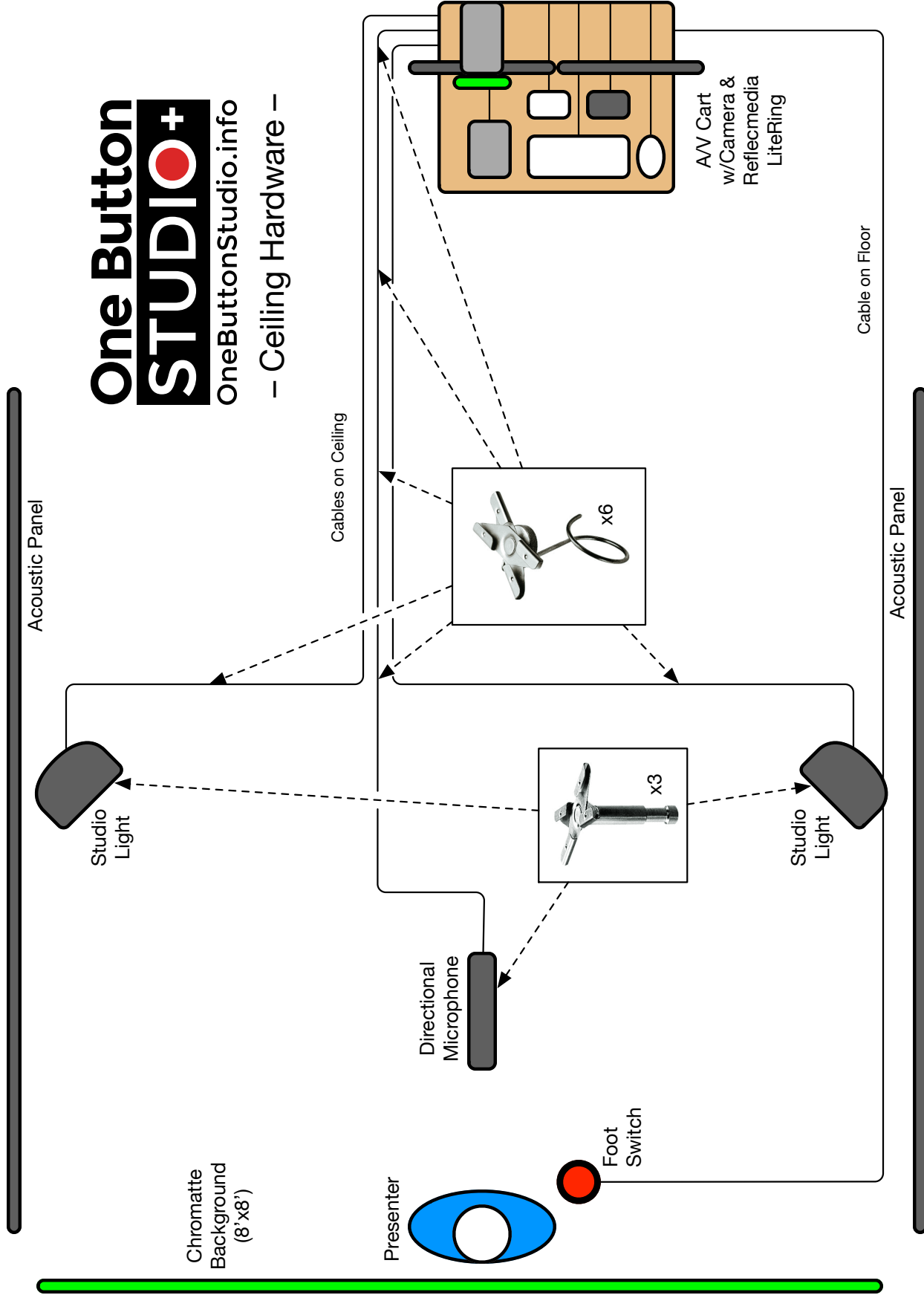
Step 2: Camera Mounting & Cable Connections
